




STANDARD PARTIES:

HUNT FOR HISTORY WITH GEORGE WASHINGTON

It's 1789 and George Washington is sitting in New York City as America's first president! Would you like to meet him? President Washington guides kids on a scavenger hunt through the Museum, visiting the camp bed he slept in during the American Revolution and a replica of his house on Cherry Street. Kids get tips as they read the Inaugural Address and sign the

Constitution. This Washington can even create tri-corner hats out of balloons! A special Washington birthday cake, inspired crafts, gift bags and balloons complete this truly presidential experience, ideal for ages 7-10.

CELEBRATE WITH COLONIAL CORNELIA

What was it like to be a kid in New York during the Colonial years? Cornelia van Varick was eight years old in 1700 and she knows exactly the kinds of things kids liked to do! Cornelia will bring her favorite toys to share with the party, like Ninepins and the



Game of Graces. She'll show the kids important skills like how to cross-stitch and use quill pens. This Colonial gal can even sing some nursery rhymes and twist a balloon animal or two! Special scavenger hunt, cross-stitch themed cake, Ninepin- decorating craft, gift bags and balloons complete this truly colonial experience, ideal for ages 5-8.

AROUND THE WORLD WITH NELLIE BLY

America's inspirational female star reporter takes this party on a trip around the world!
