





This exciting Museum-wide celebration of the life and legacy of Founding Father Alexander Hamilton features artifacts and documents from the collections of the New-York Historical Society and the Gilder Lehrman Institute of American History that bring to life the remarkable achievements of the man who, until recently, was mostly known as the face on the \$10 bill. Hamilton's connection to New York and his lasting influence on U.S. government come together in this summer-long exploration, allowing visitors to discover even more about this American hero, now enjoying fervent popularity thanks to the history-making, Tony Award-winning Broadway musical *Hamilton* and the best-selling biography by Ron Chernow. *Summer of Hamilton* also offers engaging and interactive Friday evening programs including a free film series that looks at the musicals that inspired Lin-Manuel Miranda's *Hamilton*, and family-friendly activities every weekend.
